2012 Southeast Georgia Master Cattlemen's Program

The Tattnall County Cooperative Extension Office will be hosting a Master Cattlemen's Course this winter. It will be held on Monday nights from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m., beginning on January 23rd and running through March 5th. The meetings will be held at the Vidalia Onion and Vegetable Research Center, 8163 Hwy 178, Lyons, GA 30436.

Attached is an agenda which will give the class dates, and topics for each session. As you view the agenda, you will see that this is a great opportunity to hear an Extension specialist virtually every area of cattle production. Only two Master Cattlemen's courses are offered statewide each year. Another Master Cattlemen's course will not be held in Southeast Georgia for at least two years.

The program will be open to several surrounding counties and will be **limited to the first 100 producers** that sign up. There is an \$80.00 charge for this course that will include: a copy of the "Master Cattlemen's" notebook, refreshments at all meetings, a steak dinner at the final session, and everyone attending five of the seven sessions will receive a certificate of completion and a Master Cattlemen's cap.
