A two day clinic for horse and rider will be held for instruction on reined work and cow work.

INFORMATION

The clinic will be held at the University of Georgia Animal & Dairy Science Livestock Instructional Arena, located on South Milledge and Simonton Bridge Roads.

Clinic participants must pre-register by September 7, 2009.

The clinic will start at 8:00 am each day.
